Fire and the resulting smoke from home and industrial accidents cause millions of dollars in damage each year. Conventional methods of fire and smoke damage remediation are extremely expensive and time consuming. The lingering offensive odor from tobacco smoke and yellowing from nicotine stains are major problems as well. Finally, there is a safe product that removes creosote, smoke and soot. **OLD SMOKY® Creosote, Smoke & Soot Remover** attacks the odor causing residue from fire and tobacco.

**OLD SMOKY®** is a non-hazardous product formulation that meets or exceeds EPA and California Code 65 Requirements for toxicity and safety for humans and the environment.

**OLD SMOKY®** breaks the odor causing chains of hydrocarbons into shorter hydrocarbon factions that are non-polluting. These shortened factions do not cause odor or yellowing but are simply inert molecules of carbon, oxygen, etc. When **OLD SMOKY®** is applied to smoke stains or soot and the wash is discharged into the drain or onto soil, naturally occurring microbes consume the resulting factions. Smoke odor in fire damaged attics can be remediated by applications of **OLD SMOKY®** via a low pressure spray or mist/vapor delivery system.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is not normally required when using **OLD SMOKY®**, but when you apply any chemical mist, always wear a mask or breathing apparatus.

**OLD SMOKY®** can be applied directly to the stain on most furniture surfaces by using a mist sprayer. Follow with a clean moistened wipe. Always test colorfastness of fabrics before treating large areas. Drapery

and clothing articles, as well as hard non-porous items such as glassware, ceramics, cast or molded items, may be immersed in a diluted solution of **OLD SMOKY®**.

A 1:5 solution of **OLD SMOKY®** in water ratio is recommended for most items that are immersed. DO NOT use on plaster, Styrofoam® or soft alloy aluminum items.

**OLD SMOKY®** is ideal for weekend trips to the cabin as it eliminates yellow nicotine stains and odor from painted woodwork, wall paper, clothing and furniture.

**OLD SMOKY®** is safe for use in the preparation of timber in log home construction, where creosote coating must be treated or removed prior to assembly.

**OLD SMOKY®** also eliminates odor and removes smoke stains from camping and hunting gear, clothing and vehicle interiors.

*IN CASE OF INGESTION/SPILL: If ingested, drink several glasses of water. DO NOT induce vomiting. Contact your physician, if symptoms of discomfort occur or persist. Large spills may be safely flushed down the drain with no harm to the landscape or environment.*
